The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants:

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	Nov. 5th 2025
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	Feb. 6th 2026
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	Feb. 18th 2026
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	1 week from the issuing of the offer of a place.
